Weitere Informationen: The course introduce students to current empirical and theoretical research on the expectation formation of economic agents, and the potential implications of expectations for economic decision making. This will enable participants to better understand the expectation formation process of market participants, which is especially important when facing major changes in the economic environment. Apart from the course's topical focus, advising during the course will prepare students for writing their Master's thesis. One focus will be extensive work on students' communication skills, both verbal and in writing. On voluntary basis and with instructor's consent, there is also the option to conduct a small empirical (replication) study as the course project.
