Weitere Informationen: The purpose of this seminar is to introduce students to the basic empirical methods currently used in Applied Microeconometrics and Empirical Political Economics, with a strong methodological and empirical focus. These methods can also be applied to other fields of empirical research with numerous applications in academia, as well as in the public and private sectors. The topics include fiscal policy, favoritism, governmental structure, direct democracy, and ideology. Students will have the option to evaluate an empirical paper (referee report) or replicate an empirical paper using R or Stata (replication report), depending on their preferences and skills.
